## **Better understanding of published drill intercepts using data analytics**

**Discussion Leader: Jonathan Longe, President Corebox.net**



Inspired by Wayne Hewgill's popular Drill Tracker newsletter, Jonathan Longe has developed interactive graphs at Gradewise.net to compare the drill intercepts released by public companies each morning with previously released intercepts.

The presentation looks back at the published results of projects that have been acquired by majors and compares those results with recent discoveries. The presentation also introduces tools to quantify smearing - the enriching of sub-economic low-grade intervals with higher-grade "included" intervals.

Jonathan Longe is the Founder and CEO of Corebox.net - a website that displays interactive 3D models for mining investors and analysts. For more than three years he co-chaired the AME's Roundup Coreshack Selection Committee. He got his start in the industry splitting core, dirt-bagging and getting way too close to bears near Stewart, BC.
